# Second Phase of EU Cosmetics Test Ban Now in Effect

On March 11, 2009, the European Union's ban on using animals for the testing of cosmetics ingredients came into effect. Under the 7<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the Cosmetics Directive, marketing of products whose ingredients have been tested are also banned. Finished product testing and the sale of finished products that have been tested on animals have been banned since 2004 under the Directive's amendment. This most recent deadline exempts tests for repeated-dose toxicity, reproductive toxicity and toxicokinetics. These tests will be banned in the final phase of the amendment, which will be in March 2013. The EU ban does not cover household products.
